

Requirements to be inducted to work Underground at Integra coal are:-

- Complete the **Induction Booking Form**.
- Complete **Company Details Form** (If not previously supplied or any changes to details)
- Complete the **Induction Information Form**.
- Complete the **Statement of Competency Form**. This form then needs to be signed by your site contact.
- Attach all required paperwork such as trade papers, medical, tickets; and supply evidence of experience in underground coal mining.
- Write a **letter addressed to the Manager of Mining Engineering** verifying that the employee has been assessed as competent (by the company they are employed under) in the following hazards.
  - Hydraulics Hazard Awareness
  - Electrical Hazard Awareness
  - Conveyor Hazard Awareness
  - Roof, Ribs and Sides Hazard Awareness
  
- If the work on site is **Electrical** you need to send all paperwork as required by the Electrical Engineering Standards Form.
- If the work on site is **Mechanical** you need to send all paperwork as required by the Mechanical Engineering Standards Form.

Once the forms have been and returned to Pegasus Safety the applicant can then be booked into and proceed with the induction.

**Please Note:** These requirements may take some time to process, so get your paperwork in as quickly as possible so we can proceed with the induction.
